Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Wednesday 15th July 2022

The Meeting commenced at 7.45 pm

1. Open Forum

Mrs Horsley attended to advise Councillors that a resident has mentioned speeding in the village. The Councillors advised that they had discussed the possibility of a speed sign with the Highways Taskforce Team when they came to visit today. She has also had a resident asking about a play area for the children. This has been looked at before and there is no available land to site a play area and also the expense for the insurance and the compulsory annual play equipment checks are very expensive. There has been a request by a clothing bank (ASTCO) to site a clothing bank in the area. After some discussion it was agreed that there is no available site to locate one and somebody would need to monitor it to ensure that no clothing was left nearby or other non clothing items were left.
