Matters arising

Mark out Land on the Mask Moving the PC boundary North has been discussed and is being looked at. There was some time spent working out the exact size of the PC land.

Interpretation Board for Mask Ings –This was discussed under Open Forum at the AGM prior to this meeting and it was agreed that, as the Heritage Lottery funding has now all been used, that we would put this project to one side until more funding is available.

Dog fouling signs on Mask Lane – Cllr Readman has made some new signs and will put these up. Clerk to put up new sign on gate at end of Mask Lane. No particular issues reported.

Pathway near River Still waiting for the Footpaths Officer to have a meeting with Cllr Readman to agree the exact position of the footpath. The Council agreed that they would then arrange for the area to be flayed at the end of summer, after the breeding season. The kissing gate towards Kexby Bridge is still broken.

Community Benefit Fund - Clerk advised that this has still not been set up by Legal Dept @ ERYC. She will continue chasing for information updates. Once the wheel wash is in place they will issue an invoice to the quarry landowner for the Fund account to be opened.

Erection of 2 dwellings & associated vehicle access

The Councillors wished to raise an objection to the fact that this application allowed no space between the buildings on either side and would not have the openness of other properties in the village. They also expressed concern about the tight parking and the lack of space to turn vehicles around within the curtilage. This would mean vehicles reversing out onto a narrow road with vehicles likely to be parked opposite.
