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**Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2019**

## **Open Forum**

A resident brought a concern that a white powder substance was being put down in his garden. They did not have a sample of this. Because of concern for their cats they have put up security lighting to, hopefully, deter the person doing this. The Councillors agreed that the rest of the village should be made aware of this via e-mail and Facebook. Also to mention getting a sample for Environmental Health to test.

There was concern about the removal of the Hedgerow to the South and West ( behind the pub car park ) of Whitelands. The Council confirmed that they were already aware and the Planning Enforcement Officer had been contacted. Constant fires were also mentioned so the Clerk was asked to advise the PEO of this also.
