Change of use of 1st floor living accommodation to 3 en-suite guest bedrooms and installation of external stairway with covered walkway, erection of single storey extension to rear and erection of a detached building for use as 3 en-suite guest bedrooms and associated car parking Location: Half Moon Main Street Newton Upon Derwent East Riding Of Yorkshire YO41
