Half Moon Planning App	Officers confirm no decision made as yet.
Water on Highways	Still awaiting date for Officer to attend
Wilberfoss Quarry Fund	Some of the funds are to be spent on re-painting the phone box that houses the defibrillator and a new grit bin for the side of the bus shelter.
Carr Lane Collapse	Still no response from highways. Clerk to request again.
Slow down signs	The poles will be put in place tomorrow by Cllrs Readman & Horsley and Andy Hill has offered to attach the signs.
Deeds for Nanny Leytons	Cllr Horsley has spoken to Clubleys to try and get some resolution. In process of going through HM Land Registry.
Pathway near River	Clerk contacted ERYC footpaths officer and they advised that it is the responsibility of The Environment Agency but agreed to do a one off cut mid October. She later agreed to add to their schedule for next year. Also confirmed that the missing/damaged kissing gate was scheduled for repair.
Missing Village sign	Clerk contacted Highways and they confirmed that a sign was on order.

Village upkeep:

Parking	The current situation is the same with many work vehicles parked around the north end of Main St. causing some issues. The builders are trying to keep the roadway free as much as possible.
Footpaths/verges	No new issues reported but it was noted that the general condition of the paths is deteriorating.
Roads	Still concerns over road surface at south end of village. Clerk to contact Highways again.
Litter	Cllr Wheeler commented on the amount of litter being left in the passing places on Bull Balk. Clerk to contact highways to see if it is possible to put Passing Place only signs up and signs against littering.
Dog Fouling	No new issues reported

Clerk asked that the de-fibrillator be checked more regularly.
